OUR HISTORY + BIG CHANGES COMING

The Rocky Butte Farmers Market began as a pop-up in the Madison South neighborhood during the summer of 2019, became a monthly market in 2021, and expanded to a weekly market in 2022 and 2023. This meant a significant increase in employee hours to support our vendors, recruit and retain volunteers, and operate the market along with the Kid's Patch, Community Table and music entertainment schedule. In response to patron and vendor feedback, we will be moving the 2024 Rocky Butte Farmers Market to a more visible location along NE 82nd Ave. We are close to having the new location confirmed and will be making an official announcement soon!
